Visa Example



1 - date of issue,

2 -citizenship in Russian ("Дания" means Denmark),

3 -family, given and middle names in Russian and in English,

4 – passport number,

5 – purpose of the visit,

6 – spelling of the name in the machine readable zone. Please be aware that it may differ from the spelling in the passport.

7 – validity period of the visa,

8 - visa number,

9 – number of allowed entries. "1" stands for one entry, "2" for two entries and "M" for many entries,

10 – visa type. The most common are following types:

OT – tourist visa, OД – business visa, OГ – visa for those participating in cultural, scientific, sports etc. events, OЧ – private visa, OP – work visa, OY – study visa.

11 - number of days you are allowed to stay in Russia within the validity period of the visa or per period of 180 days if you have a multiple entry visa for one or more years.

12 - sex, "муж" means male, "жен" means female,

13 – date of birth.
